2021 Grade School, Jr. High and High School Art Shows

1. The 2021 PCAA Grade School, Jr High and High School Art Shows will be held beginning Monday, May 3. All youth shows will be displayed in the lobby of City Central, with the Grade School Show being displayed from May 3-7 and the Junior High and High School Shows running from May 10-14. All three shows are available for viewing on their respective dates from 7:30am to 5:30pm. There is no entry fee for youth shows, and anyone in 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade in the Kay County or surrounding areas are eligible to exhibit. There will be no Opening Reception for this year's youth shows.
2. Maximum number of entries is one for grades 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> and three entries for Grades 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> with Juniors and Seniors being able to exhibit up to 5 entries based on their portfolio. Entries may all be in one medium or in different media.
3. Entries will be accepted from teachers, students or guardians from 9am to 2pm Tuesday through Friday beginning April 13 through April 23, or by appointment. To make an appointment for a drop off outside these hours, please contact Terron at the PCAA. All entries can be picked up beginning May 18 unless prior arrangements have been made.
4. If there are fewer than four individual artists entered in a category, then it will be at the discretion of the judge if ribbons are to be awarded.

**Media category guidelines:**

5. Two or three dimensional artwork in oil/acrylic, watercolor, graphics (includes drawing, pencil, pen and ink, pastel), photography, mixed media, ceramics, sculpture and fiber.
6. In all categories, entries must be of works completed in the last two years and not previously exhibited in an annual PCAA competition. If student desires to enter a piece of art done in years past, it shall be left to the discretion of the curating committee whether the work shall be accepted.
7. Award levels will be given as follows to the Grade School, Junior High and High School Shows respectively: One Overall Best of Show. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each media depending on entries.
